PRODUCTION 6000 bottles

GRAPE VARIETY 50% chardonnay, 50% vidal

DESCRIPTION Bright and golden colour. Its bouquet evokes peat, undergrowth and white pear. The palate reveals aromas of vanilla, blond tobacco and white flowers. It's tannins are with round, richly blended and beautifully structured.

12,5% alc./vol. / 750 ml

SUGAR 4 g/L

AGING Fermented in oak casks, of which 30% are new. During the winter, over a period of approximately 90 days, the cellar master stirs the wine to dislodge the dregs and restore their state of suspension for more volume and richness. Overall the aging process lasts 12 months.

SERVING TEMPERATURE 12° to 14°C

RECOMMENDED STORAGE Good aging potential of 3 to 5 years, can be enjoyed with great happiness now.
